Primary Responsibilities and Duties

- To collaborate with clinical researchers in the design, conduct, analysis and reporting of clinical research projects, primarily in non-randomized studies and systematic reviews
- To provide methodological consultation services to clinical researchers
- To mentor clinical researchers

- To conduct seminars and workshops for the training in clinical research methods
- To contribute towards the training and support role of the Singapore Branch of the Australasian Cochrane Centre
- To develop a research domain expertise
- To continuously seek to improve knowledge of epidemiologic methods
- To develop expertise in the use of relevant data analysis software
- To maintain the necessary project administration and technical documents
- To participate regularly to the Department's journal club & other meetings

What we are looking for

- Bachelor's degree in medicine, nursing, pharmacy, veterinary medicine or life sciences and a Master's degree or higher in epidemiology, public health, health services research, pharmaco-economics or biostatistics.
- Familiarity with at least one of the major statistical software packages e.g. SPSS, Stat, SAS, R. Able to effectively communicate research methodology concepts to clinical researchers.
- Possess good problem solving, communication and organizational skills
- Excellent team player and self-motivated
