Precision Health Research, Singapore (PRECISE) is the central entity set up to coordinate a whole of government effort to implement Phase II of Singapore's 10-year National Precision Medicine (NPM) strategy.

PRECISE is part of the Consortium for Clinical Research and Innovation Singapore (CRIS) umbrella of research-related business entities.

About the role

As Manager in the Chief Scientific Officer's Office, you will assist the PRECISE leadership team to deliver the scientific ambitions of the National Precision Medicine (NPM) programme. You will work closely with PRECISE Chief Scientific Officer.

Responsibilities:

- Refine and articulate the scientific strategy for the NPM programme
- Identify and review innovative opportunities for scientific exploration, including potential technology platforms (eg informatic, assay) and scientific applications
- Help to develop the data science and analytic capabilities of PRECISE, including genomics, molecular epidemiology, computational biology, health informatics, precision medicine and precision health
- Act as an initial point of contact for scientific issues relating to the programme, developing interactions between the NPM team and scientific partners and stakeholders in academic, industry, healthcare, policy and related settings.
- Coordinate between different research performers to promote use of NPM resources by qualified researchers and deliver on program milestones
- Assist PRECISE CSO and leadership team to refine and articulate the scientific strategy to seek funding for Phase III of the NPM programme
- Support colleagues from across PRECISE to deliver on their objectives and roles
