Head, National Coordinating Body (Clinical Trials), SCRI (3-year contract)

We are looking for a motivated individual who will be spearheading the National Coordinating Body efforts for SCRI. As the Head, National Coordinating Body for Clinical Trials for SCRI, this position will report to the Senior Director and be responsible for the following:

- 1. To lead the Clinical Trial National Coordinating Body (NCB) that is hosted within SCRI, and manage all initiatives and deliverables proposed that will enhance the clinical trial ecosystem in Singapore;
- 2. To engage members of the National Clinical Trial Steering Committee (NCTSC) and various clinical clusters in Singapore, to strategise and operationalise programmes and initiatives that would enhance the clinical trial ecosystem;
- 3. To monitor metrics that would assess the progress of clinical trials in Singapore;
- 4. To support the training and development of various functional staff that would serve to facilitate the conduct of clinical trials;
- 5. To support SD Operations SCRI in tasks that would bolster the Singapore clinical trials ecosystem.

This position is an independent senior manager with both operational and people management experience. He/She must understand the process of drug development and the local context of how drug development is conducted. He/She should be a person who works well with people and be process-driven to accomplish various projects that are tasked to the NCB.

The ideal candidate for this position should possess the following:

- Minimum Bachelor's Degree in life sciences, biology or related field. Preference will be given to someone with an advanced degree in the sciences;
- At least five (5) years' experience at middle/senior management level in a related organization, with a proven track record in the development of drugs and/or medical devices;
- Strong interpersonal skills to effectively lead, motivate and influence various internal and external stakeholders:
- Good familiarity with the Singapore research landscape and its various players;
- A problem-solver who is able to think out of the box to achieve desired goals and results;
- Some experience working in a biotech/pharmaceutical company will be preferred;
- A good team player who is able operate cross-functionally with key stakeholders;
